




- lack of political will
 - anti-gypsyism
- low use of EU funds
 - lack of national co-funding
 - lack of administrative capacity
 - administrative burden
- lack of sustainability
 - non-integrated measures
 - non-integration in mainstream public services
- lack of involvement of Roma
