

"Transnational Cooperation on Roma Community and Social Exclusion. New opportunities for the upcoming period of Structural Funds (2007-2013)"

This working seminar is the first step to set up an exchange and learning network to tackle problems faced by the Roma community in many European countries.

The Structural Funds 2007-2013 reinforce the principle of transnationality and/or territorial cooperation. In this regard, we offer an opportunity to establish a European network amongst all the organizations administering and developing interventions under the structural funds aimed at improving the Roma community's social inclusion.

The ESF Administrative Unit in Spain and the Fundación Secretariado Gitano (FSG), with the support of the FIIAPP, organise this seminar in Madrid. The seminars' main purpose is to lay the grounds for a future and stable cooperation for the following 6 years.

This first meeting's aim is to gather in-depth knowledge of the activities of the Structural Funds foreseen in each Member state targeting the Roma community; to investigate the exchange opportunities of the transnationality and/or territorial cooperation priority: and, finally, to put forward cooperation proposals between Member states.
